Hi Tony,

Sorry for the delay in getting back to you regarding the written commitment for the relocation of the cycle hire docking station from Alfred Place to Store Street. I hope that the information provided below in this email is sufficient for you.

Discussions have occurred between the Cycle Hire Team within Transport for London and Camden Council, namely between Chris Kemp and Costa Kakouratos (both cc'd in). It was agreed between the two that the existing docking station on Alfred Place would be removed and relocated to the new proposed site on Store Street by TfL, both docking stations will not be in place at once.

With regards to the funding of the relocation, a funding arrangement has been agreed and is in place as Costa accepted the quote for the works provided by Chris. Costa has informed me that the funding has come from the West End Project budget. If you wish to discuss this further then Costa Kakouratos is best to advise you on this. Similarly with timescales, this is another discussion for outside of the planning process however TfL will be undertaking the works in liaison with Camden, if further information is required then please contact Costa who can discuss the timings of the works with Chris Kemp. If you would like reassurance we would be happy to accept a compliance condition.

Let me know if you have any further questions. An update when the planning application has been put forward for approval would be much appreciated.
