

Timber Screen to Northern Boundary at 41 Frognal Landscape Report for Planning

This application is for a timber screen structure, located within the plot of 41 Frognal along a substantial length of the northern boundary.

The purpose of the structure is to provide a uniform and attractive screen to hide the assortment of existing boundary treatments offered by the three neighbouring plots to the garden at 41 Frognal.


The height of the screen has been proposed in consultation with the owners of Nos 1, 2 and 3 Frognal Close.

In the section adjacent to No1 Frognal Close, the screen will exceed the height of the existing boundary fence, to an agreed height, preventing overlooking.

In the section adjacent to No2 Frognal Close the screen will not exceed 1m in height from the ground level along their boundary.

In the section adjacent to No3 Frognal Close the screen will not exceed the height of their own boundary.




















Plan of northern boundary showing extent of screen 1:200@A3

Timber treatment: Northern Boundary Screen

Image shows the slatted Iroko timber treatment proposed for the screen, as viewed from 41 Frognal.

Where the screen is visible from No 1 Frognal Close (ie where it exceeds the height of the existing boundary fence) this treatment will also be used on the northerly side facing the neighbours.
