

CREST COPING BASIC FIXING DETAILS

- 1. Check fixing background for suitability and fixing type.
- 2. Setup brackets at each end of run (if very long run, split into sections).
- 3. Mark out brackets at maximum 750mm intervals.
- 4. Line or laser level from the two fixed end brackets.
- Fix first corner if applicable.
 Complete corner with half bracket and jointing bracket.

- 6. A bead of silicone should be applied to each side of the flat supporting area on the jointing brackets prior to the next section being rolled over into place.
- 7. Fix all the intermediate brackets, fixing packing and shimming as necessary.
- 8. Slide a double bracket under the opposite end of the coping so half of the bracket can be seen,

- ensure it is level and in line with the rest of the brackets, fix to the wall through the two visible bracket holes.
- Rivet coping to all brackets using an aluminium or stainless steel structural rivet.
- 10. Cut edges and rivets should all be touched up.
