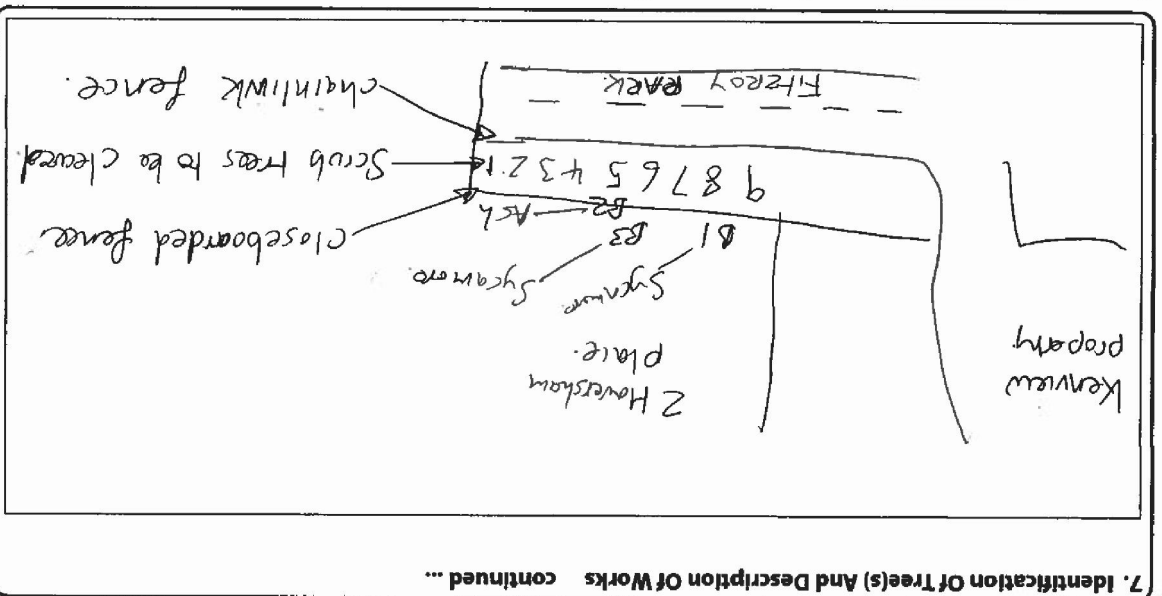

Tree felling & pruning list and locations

9x scrubland self set trees to remove . Mixture of sycamore and holly ,hawthorn. Stem diameter range from 10cm to 20cm.

Reason for clearing the banking is due to safety. Recently a tree fell over onto the road in Fitzroy park . The residents of Fitzroy park have requested the trees be cleared.

The trees are situated between a chainlink fence and a closeboarded fence at the rear of 2 Haversham Place. The strip of land on the steep banking is approximately 4m wide and 15m long.

Trees marked B1 -Sycamore B3 - Sycamore , are situated at the top of the banking and require a crown reduction of 3m and the ivy removed.

Tree marked B2 -Ash is to be removed.- reason = self set tree growing to close to larger mature sycamores.
