Proposed Work:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Fig (T1) - Reduce height by 15% by means of removing non-fruiting branches only.

1 X Fig (T1B Located behind T1) - Reduce height by 20%.

REAR GARDEN: 1 xAcer - (T2 adjacent stairway) - Reduce extraneous branches back into main crown structure (approx. 15% reduction) to shape and balance. Thin crown density by 15%.

- 1 x Hornbeam (T3) Reduce crown by approximately 30%.
- 1 x Holly (T4) Reduce crown by approximately 20% to tidy and balance crown.
- 2 x Limes(T5 & T60 Reduce lateral and sub-lateral branches of both trees which is growing into Holly by 1m.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 12 May 2020 and does not wish to object.
