I am writing in support of the planning application made by my neighbour at number 98 Highgate West Hill.

I have known Zenon and Marta for a number of years and we enjoy a good relationship as neighbours. I have been given detailed information about the project before and after planning and throughout construction. The builders have also carried out some essential damp proofing works to our shared boundary wall on our behalf.
