Dear Ms Chana,

I write to you with regard to Application number 2020/1332/P concerning the installation of 2 5G antennae at St Mary's Vicarge, 134A Abbey Road.

[REDACTED] and I am horrified that the Vicarge has been chosen for the antennae. I strongly object to this application and urge you to reject the application made on the below grounds stated.

The area is one which is very much a conservation area - one I urge be left to manage and protect the special architectural and historic features that make the area special.

The church is a listed building to which it's historic design should be protected. The inclusion in the application of changes to the concrete slabs do not appear to adhere to the building as listed.

The impact on the residents, our health and the environment must be taken into consideration. I have a 2 year old son and am extremely concerned with the affects and hazards the 5G installation would have on his health and the environment given it will substantially increase exposure to radio-frequency electro magnetic fields on top of the 2G,3G and 4G telecommunications that are already in place.

I ask that this objection is carefully considered and the application is subsequently rejected.
