Thank you for allowing me to comment on planning application 2020/2620/A for Inverness Street, NW1 and the proposal installing commemorative pavement stones as part of 'Camden Music Hall of Fame'.

I have no objections to the proposal but have the following comments and recommendations to make.

**Comments and Recommendations**

- Inverness Street is a busy location both during the day and night due to the regular street market and the close proximity of a number of night time economy venues being located there. The proposal will make the area more appealing to visitors and tourists alike therefore an increase in pedestrian foot fall will be likely. Certainly an attraction like this will attract groups to stop in the locations shown so that they can look at who is being commemorated. Appreciate it may be difficult to actually decide who will be 'visited' the most out of all the names being considered but I would certainly place the ones which are more famous closer to the main pedestrian route of Camden High Street so that there is more activity. Further down Inverness Street there are a number of blind corners, due to the neighbouring building line, and also the well-established trees. All these provide an element of 'cover and concealment' and reduce the effects of existing lighting and the CCTV in the area. Consideration to groups standing in these locations must be made and addressing any issues identified.
