Dear Ms Smith,

I have lived in Hampstead with my family for over twenty years. We are deeply attached to Hampstead and to the Heath. I walk past the site next to Jack Straw's most days, sometimes twice a day.

One key reason for rejecting previous schemes is that the site is on the edge of Metropolitan Open Land. Building houses as proposed would give the land an urban aspect and irreparably harm the view from inside the Heath or from North End Way.

All the Heath deserves permanent protection. Irrespective of size, style and location urbanisation is inappropriate and I would like to object to the scheme.
