The sun however comes from this direction and after 2pm, we have no sun in the garden, so I have never put up a higher physical barrier as this will cut out more light and make us feel enclosed. I am fine with the neighbours proposal of redoing their glass extension, but adding an external balcony means that I will now be overlooked and especially in spring and autumn when the leaves of the plant between us disappear.
