- e.g. Oak (T3) fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.
- T1 Cherry Tree is infected with Ganoderma and therefore has limited future lifespan, should the fungus start to necrotise the roots then the tree is immensely dangerous, it is impossible to establish if that process is underway. Given the tree is infected it is best to remove the risk.
- T2 and T3 2 x Lime trees reduce back to previous points of reduction, representing 2.5 to 3m to be removed from each branch, shortened furnishing growths will be left for improved crown continuity where possible. Trees shade the garden badly and have no space for future growth.
- T4 Horse Chestnut reduce back to previous points of reduction, representing 2.5 to 3m to be removed from each branch, shortened furnishing growths will be left for improved crown continuity where possible. Tree shades the garden badly and has no space for future growth.
