				2) Misdescription of the number of antennae to be installed. The title of the application suggests 6 antennae, but from a careful review of the drawings, it looks like there will actually be 9 new antennae. 6 of them for 5G and a further 3 for 3G/4G infill. The application is therefore being 'economical with the truth' and needs to be corrected.
				3) The site is in close proximity to two Infant/Junior schools and there are potentially adverse health effects of RFR on children. Have these schools been consulted in advance? There is no evidence of this on the website.
				4) There is no information on the aggregate power of the radiation form these 9 new antennae, nor on the frequency bands that they will be operating in. Under the terms of the 'Stewart Report' this information needs to be provided to residents as part of the planning application. Until it is provided, this applicatiopn cannot proceed. Once provided, the planning process 'timer' must be re-started.
