This is an application for the property 11 St Anne's Close, London, N6 6AR.

The proposed works is to put a 270cm tall wooden trellis next to the existing boundary wall on the south and south-east side of the property. The purpose is for privacy as well security, due to an incident last year of a criminal jumping over the wall to escape the police.

On the south side of the proposed trellis is flat complex:

Sonny Heights East, 3 Swain's Ln, Highgate, London N6 6QX

The flat complex has ground floor shops, whose shop storage backs up on the boundary wall. The proposed trellis would not reduce light on Sonny Heights East as the ground floor is only used for commercial storage purposes; the proposed trellis is on the north side of the property and their first floor residential window is above the proposed trellis.
