				The size of the extension means that it will remain subservient to the host building however it is a shame that the bay window feature at lower ground level of the building will be lost as a result of it being full width.
				It is good that it is not proposed that the flat roof to the extension be used as a rear terrace for the raised ground floor flat. If approval is given for this application we suggest it is specified that the new flat roof should not be used as a terrace.
				It is welcome that the proposal is to use red bricks consistent with much of the conservation area - it would be good if these were "aged/reclaimed" bricks rather than "industrial" red bricks as this would be more in keeping and sympathetic with the conservation area.
