e.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.

Front Garden:

T1: Yew: Reduce lateral and sub-lateral growth over drive and growing toward building by approximately 2.00m. Reduce remaining crown by 20% to balance. Remove Ivy and dead wood throughout.

T2: Multi-stemmed Bay: Reduce crown by 30-40%. G1: Mixed Species Hedge - Viburnum and Pittisporum. Reduce by 20% to tidy.

Rear Garden:

T3: Oak: Basal cavity noted. Raise crown skirt by approximately 1.50-2.00m. Thin crown density by 20%. Reduce lateral and sub-lateral branches growing toward house and over balcony by 20-25% (approximately 2.00m). Reduce remaining extraneous growth back into main crown structure (not more than 20%). Remove dead wood throughout crown.

T4: Beech: Located in neighbouring property. Thin crown density by approximately 20%. Raise crown by approximately 2.00m. Remove dead wood

throughout.

- T5: Ŏak: Remove epicormic growth. Thin crown density by 10%. Remove dead wood throughout.
- T6: Laurel: Fell to approximately 1.00m in height.
- G2: 3 x Beech (forming informal hedge line): Reduce crown by 20%. Thin crown density by 25%. G3: Yew Hedge: Reduce by approximately 30%.

Reasons: General maintenance and to control encroachment.
