Which was only granted based on subscription, having been here for almost two decades.</p> <p>The installation of this terrace would be grossly unfair on those properties who have applied and been denied such a terrace, based on the conservation area restrictions.</p> <p>Any screening will affect the roof line, we ourselves could only install a balustrade, based on the previous character of those installed when we purchased the property.</p> <p>The installation of a roof light on this property has already caused issue in terms of blinding sunlight reflecting into our terrace, something which will need to addressed, as it is genuine hazard.</p> <p>The application was initially rightfully denied, and that decision should be upheld based on the factors detailed above.
