- 1. The above tree works are proposed as a remedy to the differential foundation movement at the insured property and to ensure the long-term stability of the buildina.
- 2. The above tree works are proposed to limit the extent and need for expensive and disruptive engineering repair works at the insured property. In this instance the estimated repair costs are likely to vary between £13,000 and £60,000, depending upon whether the tree/s can be removed or must remain.

- 6.Insurers understanding the requirement to offer replacement planting in the event consent to fell is granted.
