We strongly object to the felling of the 4 trees!!

The 4 trees (Apple, Olive, Dogwood, Eucalyptus) are sizeable (I enclose one photo due to email size) and have been there for at least 50 years.

Olive is very rare in Britain, originating in the Mediterranean. It's a tree than can leave for hundred of years. Eucalyptus originates in Australia.

They are of a variety that makes a major contribution to the habitat for birds, squirrels and insects.

By absorbing carbon dioxide they contribute to reduction in global warming.

Felling the four to ground level is nothing short of an act of barbarism and substantial damage to wild life and the environment.

In addition, felling the trees will reduce much our privacy. Allowing residents of the new development direct observation into our property.

Two of the trees are opposite my window allowing privacy and shade. The new development is causing much disturbance already. Felling the trees will impact our quality of life and reduce the value of our property.
