Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Magnolia (T1) - Remove the Rose from upper crown and reduce it back to main stems in the central crown area. Reduce and reshape the crown as is required after Rose removal (not more than 20%) as the Rose is adding to the trees wind sail area and is beginning to suppress some healthy leaf growth in the upper crown.

1 x Japanese Maple (T2) - Reduce crown by approx. 20%. Thin crown density by 20%.

Row of Magnolia Grandiflora (G1) - Reduce back over neighbouring property by approx. 1m. Reduce crown heights by 1m. Reduce over lawn by approx. 0.5m.

- 1 x Large Bay (T3) Reduce crown height by approx. 40%. Reduce lateral and sub-lateral branches as hard back as is practicable to balance (approx. 20%) and shape.
- 1 x Griselinia (S1) Trim back to previous reduction points.
- 1 x Small Bay (T4) Reduce back to previous reduction points to control encroachment (approx. 20%).
- 1 x Cherry (T5) Reduce section of crown by 20% which is overhanging the Mulberry.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 29 July 2020 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.
- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
