Their appearance is out of character on an estate of mansion flats with gardens, with a pleasingly uniform appearance in the Dartmouth Park Conservation area (sub area 9.) Extensions and outhouses would be outside of the vocabulary of a Boehmer &amp; Gibbs development such as this.</li><li>2. The extension is forward of the existing line of the sweep of the buildings and should this proposal go ahead, it would set a precedent for innumerable such applications which would destroy the homogeneity of the rear elevation.</li><li>3. The view from the upper stories of the rear of the building is a highly prized aspect of living in these mansions. The prospect of looking down on a disarray of outbuildings and extensions is upsetting. The proposed structures would detract from the enjoyment of the view from the upper stories.</li><li>4. The proposed structures would prejudice the desirability and therefore the future value of these homes.</li></ol>

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
