The Spinney Triangle

A mixture of trees including mature sycamore and ash up to 100 years.. Probably all self-established. No evidence that this might be a remnant of the original woodland on the site.

No individual trees that are particularly valuable but together they form a prominent feature with significant amenity value which would probably be destroyed or at the very least reduced considerably were a garage and storage shed to be built on the site. It is difficult to see how a garage and shed could be built without cutting down some of the biggest trees which would almost certainly affect the street view.
