The DAS refers to the application as a 'starting point for discussion' (p.20) which is clearly inadequate and shows scant regard for the principles of sustainable design which should be fundamental to any new development. In particular, I would like to object to the proposed basement. The construction comprises the most unsustainable carbon-intensive residential construction imaginable. For example, the BRE Green Guide gives ratings for basement construction at 240KgCO2/Kg compared with blockwork cavity walls at 74KgCO2/Kg.
