Dear Sirs

I am writing on behalf of Christ Church School, Redhill Street NW14BD, as a governor looking after the property below.

The school own a bungalow (formally the Caretaker's home) and it falls inside a Conservation Area. In the garden is a tree that has grown close to our neighbour's wall between our bungalow and that of no 3 Edward Mews, NW1 4AT. At our neighbour's request we would like to remove this tree as it is reaching over onto their property and causing distress as it bangs on their property when its windy. But secondly, the wall itself has been compromised further down with cracking and so it would be wise to remove a tree growing along side it.
