## DECISION

Town and Country Planning Acts 1990 (as amended) NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA

Address: Inverforth House North End Way London NW3 7EU

Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Scots Pine (Pinus sylvestris) (T1) - Thin crown on the side of the lean by 20% to lessen weight, remove creeper from crown.

1 x T2 Indian Bean (Catalpa bignonioides) (T2) - Reduce back from the property by approx. 1m to give 2m clearance. To balance crown, reduce over long branches by approx. 1.5m back into the main crown to balance.

1 x Sweet Chestnut (Castanea sativa) (T3) - Selectively reduce back from property by approx. 1m to give 2m clearance. Reduce over long branches over hanging the terrace by approx. 2m back into the main crown. Selectively lift by 1m to balance skirt. Remove epicormic growth.

SIDE GARDEN: 1 x Sweet Chestnut (Castanea sativa) (T5) - Remove basal growth.

DRIVEWAY: 1 x Cypress (T6) - Fell to ground level by sectional takedown.

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Lime (Tilia spp) (T8) - Reduce crown all round to previous reduction, approx.2m leaving furnishing growth. Lift to crown break.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 25 August 2020 and does not wish to object.
