Proposal: FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Lime (T1) - Fell to ground level and treat stump.

The Council has considered your application dated 07 August 2020 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

1 This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.

Reason: To allow the Local planning authority to monitor the completion and standards of the work.

2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)

Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).

3 Between 1st November 2020 and 31st March 2021, 1x Prunus "Accolade"

(Accolade cherry tree), 14-16cm in girth measured at 1m above the root ball shall be planted within 3m of the position of the tree approved for removal and no less than 750mm from any structure unless otherwise agreed with the Council in writing. The planting process shall be in accordance with the standards set out in BS8545:2014 and shall be watered when required for at least the first three years after planting.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 206 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).
