Cut back lateral branches that extend into No. 24 back to fenceline.

Reduce Crown height by 2metres.

Reduce laterals by 0.5metres

T3 - Large Prunus

Remove dead section back to sound timber

T4 - Large Ash in Adjecent Garden –
Cut back lateral branches that extends over garden of No. 24 by 2metres back to old pruning points

T5 - Large Acer in Adjecent garden

Cut back lateral limbs that extend into garden of No. 24 by 2-3metres

T6 - Large Catalpa

Cutbak lateral branches that impact on to T7 by 1metre

T7 - Medium Almechia

Crown Reduction by 2metres (Regrowth) & reshape to suit.

T8 - Large Tulip tree – Reduce Crown central stems by 3metres.

Selectively Reduce Laterals by 2 metres to balance tree

T9 - Large Hazel -

Cutback lateral limbs that impact on to adjecent (T10) to aid growth

T11 Medium pittosporum

Cutback lateral limbs that encroach on to adjectent Almeria by 0.5-1metre to aid growth

T1 – Large Magnolia

Selectively reduce 0.5metres

GRP 1 - (Various trees Next Door) -

Cut back to fence line T3 - Pruns X2 –

Reduce Crown height by 2metres.

Reduce Laterals by 0.5metres
