The large proposed screen - black painted fret cut metal frame is completely inappropriate in style or materia for this traditional 19th century building and does not fit in with the conservation area. This building has survived relatively intact and this would destroy the appearance of this sweep of Camden conservation area historic brickwork, clearly visible.
