Its tiled green facade and external staircase (which in my experience rapidly become filthy and graffiti covered) are totally out of character for within the conservation area. Given that you as the council are supposed to protect conservation areas and if this were to go ahead would set a dangerous precedent for other invasive, inappropriate developments in the future, I beg you to reconsider the scheme and provide a building that does not totally destroy the local environment but is of a scale and design that works within it.

The proposed site is the wrong type of building, it is far too overdeveloped as its height and mass would completely dominate the surrounding houses and gardens which will change radically the aspect of the area and the mews will be dwarfed by such a structure. The green tiled surface is out of touch with the brick and stucco of the neighbouring houses and so it is the external staircase which has no relation to the look of the victorian streets and mews. It also brings back an unsuccessful design popular in comunal buildings of this type in the sixties, unsafe and prone to graffiti and vandalism. For this project I hope you would consider a smaller building and in keeping with the design of the conservation area.
