The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The proposed development, by reason of its height, massing, design and inappropriate materials, is considered to unduly dominate the rear elevation of the host property and the terrace of which it is a part and be detrimental to the local character and amenity contrary to policy D1 (Design) of the Camden Local Plan 2017 and policy 2 (Design and Character) of the Fortune Green and West Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan 2015.
- 2 The proposed development, by reason of its height, bulk, fully glazed façade and

location of the roof terrace, would give rise to an overbearing sense of enclosure and overlooking to neighbouring properties and result in harm to the amenities their occupiers by way of loss of daylight, sunlight and privacy contrary to policy A1 (Managing the impact of development) of the Camden Local Plan 2017.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraph 38 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2019.
