Raising the roof would introduce an unsightly addition which would, in addition, disrupt the symmetry of this pair of buildings. This would be detrimental to the Conservation Area. It is noted that the submission misleadingly includes a Birds-eye view impression showing a similar roof extension on 61 which formed part of an application submitted in November 2017. The Netherhall Neighbourhood Association (NNA) objected to this application, which we note has remained undetermined by Camden for nearly 3 years. The NNA therefore object to the application to extend the roof at 63 Netherhall Gardens.
