While I appreciate that the applicant signed and agreed with the directors of the building to carry out this conversion, the rules and regulations which state that the works can be carried out during working hours were agreed back in 2018.</p> <p>However, since then the Covid-19 coronavirus pandemic has hit the UK with most of tenants in Kings Gardens now required to work from home as per governmental regulation. With London now in the Government's Tier 2 High alert level, my company has shut its offices until at least next May, meaning I have no other place to work than my own flat.</p> <p>With the proposed works to be located right above my home office, I am worried about the constant noise levels during work hours for an extended period of time, leaving me with no other place to work.</p> <p>I therefore object to these works being carried out over the next seven months.</p> <p>I do, however, appreciate that the applicant wishes to carry out these works, therefore I can agree to a postponement to the start of the works until May, 2021. I am hopeful that by then the Covid-19 situation will be less severe, while I will have the option to work from my company's office space while the works will be carried out.</p>
