The pruning was excessive to the extent that there has been no regrowth since pruning and the tree now appears dead. The poor pruning has left this beautiful tree severely disfigured with little likelihood of returning to a well-formed shape, even if it remained alive. The NNA give our comments on the basis that the owners at 16 plant a reasonable sized standard or semi mature replacement tree for the Ash after felling. We have been verbally informed by the owners that this is their intention. This should be referred to by Camden in any correspondence or approval of felling?</p> <p>We will email you separately a photograph of 12, 14 and 16 showing the condition the Ash has been left in by the over aggressive pruning and the cumulative result on these three rear gardens of felling and pruning particularly caused by the extensive felling in 12 and 14MG.</p> |
