



MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

KEIM MINERAL PAINTS – DECORATED SURFACES PERIODIC MAINTENANCE

GENERAL, NON-TRAFFICKED AREAS

Those areas subject to general depositions of grime/dirt/dust should be periodically washed down using a mild dilute detergent solution to aid the dirt removal.

Typical cycles would range from 1 – 5 years dependent upon the degree of airborne contamination.

TRAFFICKED AREAS

Those areas receiving occasional scuffmarks etc, should be washed down, again with a mild detergent solution, using a soft bristle brush.

If repeated cleaning of these areas is required it may be necessary to redecorate such areas periodically with a single coat application of the specified Keim system.

It is important to point out that when any redecoration is taking place this must be taken back to a natural breakline.

GENERAL

- Keim should readily accept cleaning with mild acid or alkaline but we do not advise the use of anti-graffiti solvents on the surfaces.
- Do not use wire brushes, stiff bristled brushes, coarse aggregate sandpapers or emery cloth.
- Keim Mineral Paints are waterborne silicate paints that do not contain any harmful solvents.
