Condition 3 (details of the facing materials) was partially discharged under planning reference 2019/6278/P. The applicant has provided details of the zinc which would be used for the cladding and roof of the single storey element as well as the cladding of the top storey of the main building. The details have been reviewed by Urban Design. The material would weather well and would develop a grey patina over time. It is considered that the material would

safeguard the appearance of the premises and the character of the immediate area.

The planning and appeal history of the site has been taken into account when coming to this decision.

The submitted details are consistent with the general expectations of the approved scheme and are acceptable in all other respects.
