01 INTRODUCTION

DESIGN STATEMENT FOR BASEMENT REFURBISHMENT PROPOSAL

This report addresses the Melia Hotel International Group's wish to refurbish a portion of the existing basement of the White House Building transforming it into a guest swimming pool and spa.

The refurbishment of the basement includes the alteration and conversion of a meeting room into a swimming pool and builds on other recent applications for the same site, with application references 2020/3754/L

The current layout and decoration of the basement was completed in the year 1999. The original interior layout or detailing do not appear to remain and this is highlighted within the Historic Building Report' which accompanies this planning application. Overall, the works will improve on the refurbishment carried out in 1999 and won't have a detrimental impact to the Listed Building.

The operator's aim is to offer an extra service to its guests whilst simultaneously upgrading a part of the building which was previously not in use. The new pool area will include a guest swimming pool as well as changing facilities and a small Sauna.

The access to the pool will be from the existing circular staircase located on the Northwestern corner of the site which connects the basement floor to the ground floor and from there to the hotel lobby. The basement pool will also have a secondary means of access and escape via an existing staircase which leads onto Albany street.

The new interior to the pool and the access zones has been designed by Melia Hotel Group's designers ASAH. The quality of the detailing and materials will enhance the quality of the hotel and will align with the operator's compromise to keep the hotel in good condition and offering good services to the clients while respecting the characteristics of the listed building.



1. Melia White House

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The building is a Grade II listed, 9 storey structure arranged in a star shape. The building was originally constructed in 1936 as serviced flats but is currently used as a hotel, known as The Melia White House Hotel. The elevations are clad in pale cream faience tiles which are slightly darker to the ground floor and to the banding at each floor.

From 1959 the building was gradually converted into a hotel and by 1970 the building operated officially in hotel use. In 1972 the hotel was purchased by Rank Organisation who undertook a three-year renovation.

During the 1980s a new lift system was installed and many of the public and private areas were refurbished,

including the main lobby, the bar and the bedrooms. By 1990 a business centre, leisure centre and new

conference and banqueting suites had been formed. Between 1974 and 1995 the building was altered with

the addition of several extensions located between the west and east wings, which on-site inspections have revealed are single storey.

Sol Meliá is the hotel operator of the building since 1999 and completed a major renovation project, including works to the entrance lobby, bedrooms, meeting rooms and restaurant. The total number of available hotel bedrooms is 548.







Key plan of existing basement




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


Key plan of existing basement











05 IMPACT TO LISTED BUILDING



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In order to guarantee the correct operation of the swimming pool services it will be necessary to introduce 2 air extraction grills on the Longford street façade.

The grills will be located at raised ground floor level on the circular volume which is located on the Longford Street corner.

The grills will feed fresh air and release exhaust air from the swimming pool plantroom located in the basement and the approximate size of the 2 grills in the façade will be 80cm High x 160cm Wide.


The grills themselves will be made of high grade metal and will be in keeping with the rest of the façade metalwork on the building.






2. Melia White House_ North façade




