TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971  
38A-42 BOUNDARY ROAD, 8-16A AND 11-17 LOUDON ROAD MEWS, N.W.8.

I refer to your letter dated 19th February, 1973, submitting details of facing materials to be used on the building proposed to be erected at 38A-42 Boundary Road, N.W.8., pursuant to Condition 1 of the planning permission dated 11th March, 1971 for the redevelopment of the above site by a six storey block comprising sixty self-contained flats, together with car parking for sixty cars.

I have to inform you that the Council hereby disapproves the use of Himley Duntex blend dark heather bricks, as facing materials, as indicated in your letter dated 19th February, 1973 for the following reasons:-

1. The proposed brick fails in colour and texture, to harmonize satisfactorily with the approved facing materials of the larger Alexandra Road site, of which this forms a part.
2. The proposed brick is considered unduly dark in colour, and may tend to accentuate the heaviness of the proposed building.
