				I accept that there is a requirement for a mixed range of housing but I suggest that HMO (low cost housing with shared facilities) is not what is in sort supply. Instead housing suitable for families is in short supply. It is primarily for this reason that I object to this application.
				Additionally, the plans show inadequate bin storage for 15 occupants on a street that already suffers from rubbish on pavements. Also, inadequate street parking for potentially 15 cars/vans on that part of the road.
				This is yet more large scale housing added to West Hampstead with no additional amenities thus causing harm to all residents.
