Proposal: REAR GARDEN: 1 x Ash (T2) - Fell to ground level

The Council has considered your application dated 21 October 2020 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

1 This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.

Reason: To allow the Local planning authority to monitor the completion and standards of the work.

2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)

Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).

3 Prior to the end of March 2020, a silver birch tree (Betula pendula) shall be

planted in the rear garden of the property unless otherwise agreed with the Council in writing. The tree shall be planted no less than 1 metre from any structure and no more than 5 metres from the position of the application tree. The tree shall be maintained in accordance with the standards set out in BS8545:2014 - Trees from the nursery to independence in the landscape. If the replacement tree dies or becomes seriously diseased within five years after planting it shall be replaced with a tree of the same species and size as that detailed in this condition.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 206 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).
