However, basements have an unhappy history in the South Hampstead Conservation Area. They destabilise the neighbouring Victorian housing stock which was built to take account of the likelihood movement in the London clay on which they were built. New basements have affected underground water movement that has lead to increased risk of flooding in neighbourhood properties. CRASH believes that new basement excavations should not be permitted because of their damaging effect both on the stability of the original building stock and on the water levels in the surrounding soil.		ay
