Western Boundary T57 Lime x 1(Tilia spp) Remove all deadwood throughout the crown. Remove all basal and Epicormic growth to crown break. Report if any defects are hidden underneath this growth Western Boundary T457.1 x 1Elaeagnus. Reduce back from footpath as far as possible to form 30-75cm. Reduce height by approx. 1m. Prune back from Magnolia. To North East of Tennis Courts T465 Common Lime x 1(Tilia x europaea) Remove Deadwood throughout crown. Check security of unions whilst within the crown and report back. North East Corner of gardens T469 Fig x 1(Ficus carica) Remove crossing branches. Gardeners have crown lifted this tree to 2.5m. Remove left hand fork overhanging footpath at 1.8m back to collar 5-7" North East Corner of gardens T470 Cherry spp x 1(Prunus acolade) Crown Thin by 30%. Reduce height by 1m. Reduce lateral growth by 2-3m to allow more light too the suppressed Fig. Crown lift 2.5m Central Garden T476 Cherry spp x 1(Prunus acolade) Crown Clean to remove crossing branches and dead wood from within the canopy. Crown lift to 2.5m. Reduce low limb on Northern side (Limb approximately 12" in diameter) by 2.5m to reduce end weight. Central Garden T477 Cherry spp x 1(Prunus acolade) Crown Clean to remove crossing branches and dead wood from within the canopy. Crown lift to 2.5m. Reduce low lateral spread on Southern and Eastern sides. (Limb approximately 12" in diameter) by 3.5m to reduce end weight (This spec has now been amended, due to visualising fruiting bodies (funghi). Southern end of Gardens T484 Lime x 1(Tilia spp) Remove all dead wood throughout the canopy. Check previous large pruning wounds and unions and report back. Central Garden T486 Acer spp x 1 Crown Lift to remove the lowest ring of branches at 2.5m. Re- reduce tree all overby 1m.
