It is proposed to construct an additional residential storey on the existing residential property a 25 Primrose Hill Road, NW3 3DG, in line with the standards set out within Class AA, Schedule 2, Part 1 of the GPDO. The proposed additional storey would be constructed on the principle part of the existing dwellinghouse.

It would accommodate 2no. bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms and closets, as well as a small laundry room. In line with the requirements, no windows will be located on the side elevations of the additional storey. Additional windows will be located in the front and rear elevations in order to provide the new bedrooms with good levels of light. The total height of the additional storey, at approximately 2.9 metres, falls well within the parameters set by the Guidance.

As demonstrated on the accompanying plans, the materials for the additional storey have been carefully selected in order to match the materials of the existing dwellinghouse. The brickwork, render and roofbox have been designed to match the existing materials. This ensures that the additional storey is seen as a natural extension of the existing dwellinghouse and not as a separate element.
