







Diagram 3D model sketch view of existing shelving for reference

This illustration shows the proposed elements that are to be retained or modified within the new kitchen plan arrangement.





#### 2.0 Proposed Kitchen Joinery 3D Model Sketch 2

Our proposal seeks to retain as much of the joinery as possible and ensure that all available wall surfaces retain the joinery. We have reviewed all of the units A,B,C,D & E and have retained the elements that we believe have the most interesting details and functional use for the new kitchen layout. It should be noted that the current existing configuration means that items A and especially B are very hard to reach and use.

Unit A is retained and relocated to be adjacent to the new hob location. Unit A is designed for pots and pans to be hung so is ideally

located as shown.

Unit B is the least useful very shallow unit and given the new door location can not be retained in the kitchen.

Unit C is retained and modifies to sit as shown on the diagram below

Unit D is retained and modified to suite the new landscape format and retains the interesting double depth of the joinery.

Unit E is not retained in the kitchen.


