Observations	<p>OBJECT</p> <p>These proposals are piecemeal and expedient. The whole triangular area needs to be comprehensively designed with consideration given to relocation of cycle stands, bins and parking, the extension of paved areas and the removal of bollards.</p> <p>The proposed bins are very prominent and large, sit awkwardly along the curved wall of no 41A Belsize Lane and are visually intrusive in the space.</p> <p>The planters obstruct pedestrian movement along Belsize Lane and their ferrous fixings are causing considerable staining on flagstones.</p> <p>The existing benches are user unfriendly and have their backs to the sun.</p> <p>Eldred Evans Chair BCAAC</p>
