1 Reason for granting approval:

An Environmental Noise Survey and Plant Noise Assessment Report prepared by KP Acoustics has been submitted to discharge condition 5. The assessment has been reviewed by the Council's Environmental Health Officer who has confirmed that with the specified noise mitigation measures, the external noise level emitted from plant equipment will be lower than the lowest existing background noise level by at least 10dBA where the source is tonal, as assessed according to BS4142:2014 at the nearest and/or most affected noise sensitive premises, with all machinery operating together at maximum capacity.

The proposed plant would therefore comply with the requirements of condition

5, and it is recommended that this condition is discharged.

As such, the details are in general accordance with the requirements of policies A1, CC1, D1 and D2 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
