I am applying for planning permission to have the two sycamore trees trimmed indicated as 1 & 2 on the attached diagram. The trees straddle the boundary of the property known as Elmwood and the verge of Wildwood Grove. There is a tree protection order for these two trees TPO C574 2006, we have trimmed these trees several times over the last ten years. This year we would like to trim them the same as the last time which was quite successful. Because there is a tree on Hampstead Way that spreads over our property indicated as 3 on the plan, we would like to face our trees on the west side to reduce the shading over our garden. This involves cutting one branch with a diameter of about 20 cm and a second of about 15 cm. in total we would be reducing the crown about 25%. The trees are in robust health and would regain their current height and density in 2 or 3 years. Best Wishes
