- Given the nature of the site and the proposals existing photographs of the front of the property showing adjoining properties is considered desirable. ✓
- Since the fenestration pattern of the windows are changing, please provide rear elevational drawings showing contextual information of adjoining properties.
- ➔ • Please provide large joinery details of all proposed windows and doors including elevations and sections at scale 1:20 and details of glazing bars at scale 1:10
- ? ➔ • Schedule of works including details of the methods for altering the rear elevation.
- ➔ • Please annotate all internal alterations and show the demolition of existing fabric.
- ➔ • Please provide existing and proposed internal elevations of new openings (eg between kitchen and dining room and alterations to chimney breast)
- Please provide details of skylight. *no change to existing* ✓
- Please provide a full photographic survey of the building. ✓
