NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA

Proposed Work:

SQUARE GARDENS WEST: 1 x Lime (*Tilia* spp) (T57) - . Remove all basal and Epicormic growth to crown break.

1 x *Elaeagnus* (T457) - Reduce back from footpath as far as possible to form 30 - 75cm. Reduce height by approx. 1m. Prune back from Magnolia.

SQUARE GARDENS NORTH EAST: 1 x Fig (*Ficus carica*) (T469) - Remove crossing branches. Remove left hand fork overhanging footpath at 1.8m back to collar 5 - 7".

1 x Cherry spp (*Prunus acolade*) (T470) - Crown Thin by 30%. Reduce height by 1m. Reduce lateral growth by 2 - 3m. Crown lift 2.5m.

SQUARE GARDENS CENTRAL: 1 x Cherry spp (*Prunus acolade*) (T476) - Crown Clean to remove crossing branches. Crown lift to 2.5m. Reduce low limb on Northern side (Limb approx. 12" in diameter) by 2.5m to reduce end weight.

1 x Cherry spp (*Prunus acolade*) (T477) - Crown Clean to remove crossing branches. Crown lift to 2.5m. Reduce low lateral spread on Southern and Eastern sides. (Limb approx. 12" in diameter) by 3.5m to reduce end weight.

1 x *Acer* spp (T486) - Crown Lift to remove the lowest ring of branches at 2.5m. Re- reduce tree all over by 1m.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 25 November 2020 and does not wish to object.

Informative(s):

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- 3 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
