What a waste of time for officers and the planning committee!</p> <p>As the neighbouring householder potentially most affected by the playhouse I fully support the application. It would be a positive enhancement to the conservation area as the gardens will be complemented by the shrieks of happy children having fun. This sound of sheer enjoyment will bring light to many in neighbouring properties in these dark times when there is so little to be happy about.</p> <p>I also support the proposal on design grounds. The juxtaposition of a modernist interpretation of a treehouse with a more traditional development made of scaffolding boards is visually educational for my children and for Loic and Hector (the proposers).
