Town and Country Planning Act, 1932.
Town and Country Planning (General) (Interim
Development) Order, 1935.

With reference to your application dated 15th February, 1937, I am directed to inform you that the Council, in pursuance of its powers under the above-named Order, hereby permits you to deviate from approved plans so as to allow the provision of a caretaker's flat at 3rd floor level at the rear of Block A of the flats on the site of No. 1, Bracknell Gardens, Hampstead, in accordance with the plan 24733 (Registered No. 33517) submitted, subject to the conditions of consent contained in the Council's letter dated 16th January, 1936, being otherwise complied with.

The permission is given in variation of that conveyed to you in the Council's letter dated 16th January, 1936, so far as relates to the work indicated on the above-mentioned plan, and is subject also to due compliance with any local Acts, regulations, building by-laws and general statutory provisions in force in the area and nothing herein shall be regarded as dispensing with such compliance or be deemed to be a consent by the Council thereunder.

I would also remind you that the Council's permission does not modify or affect any personal or restrictive covenants applying to the land or the rights of any persons entitled to the benefit thereof.
