Summary of representations (<i>Officer response(s)</i> <i>in italics</i>)	 Officer response It is not considered that the proposal would result in an undue loss of light or privacy. The proposed reeded glass would prevent office users from seeing into neighbouring windows but would allow more light into the office space unlike the existing film. Officers have conducted a site visit and viewed samples of the proposed reeded glass and are satisfied that the new glazing would prevent direct overlooking into neighbouring residential windows. Images are also provided in the submitted design and access statement which demonstrate the visual effect of reeded glass. As such, it would not be necessary to keep blinds closed to maintain privacy and subsequently suffer a loss of light.
